

# **NEWBURGH-ON-YTHAN GOLF CLUB**

## **GOLF COURSE HEALTH & SAFETY RULES**

**Effective from 9 January 2014**

**Please ensure that you abide by the following safety rules when playing golf on this course:**

- **Always stand behind the golf ball when partners are playing their shots. Do not walk ahead of anyone before they have finished playing.**
- **If you are faced with a hazard (i.e. a hill or a big gorse bush) which means that you have to play a 'blind' shot, do not proceed until you have checked that nobody is on the course in your target area. In addition, please take account of the possibility of a wayward shot and make sure that no one is in the vicinity.**
- **If there are walkers on the course where you are playing, then you must wait for them to clear the area before continuing to play. Similarly, please provide the same courtesy to those walking in areas alongside the golf course.**
- **Before hitting a drive down the 10<sup>th</sup> fairway from the 10<sup>th</sup> tee, please ensure that no cars are using the road or that no pedestrians are walking on the road (alongside the fairway) towards the car park. If there is, then please wait until they have gone safely past the 10<sup>th</sup> tee before teeing off.**

**If they are travelling away from the car park down the road, then again ensure their safety before teeing off.**

**Your help in ensuring the safety of everyone on and adjacent to the course is much appreciated and is of paramount importance for both yourself and the golf club.**
